Notes for THOMAS KILLEY:

Information provided by volunteers at the Isle of Man web site suggests Thomas Killey was baptized October 6, 1793 and born to William Killey/Kelly (b. abt 1762) and Ann Gill, who married January 27, 1787 in Lezayre, Isle of Man. Their other children were Edmund Kelly b. 3 July 1796, Edward b. 22 February 1802, Evan b. 24 April 1799, John b. 22 August 1790, Robert b. 15 July 1804, John b. 12 July 1789. (Is it possible that the two Johns (1790 and 1789) are one and the same, perhaps one date is the birth date and the other is the baptism date?)

1851 Mersea Twp. Canada Census, page 37:

Thos. Kelley, farmer, origin Isle of Man, religion Church of England, age on next birthday 60, Male. (He may have died between 1851 and 1861 since he does not appear in the 1861 census.)

Elizabeth (Kewney) Killey was born June 8, 1794 in Lezayre, Isle of Man to John Kewney and Catherine Corlette, who married November 26, 1788 in Ballaugh, Isle of Man.

She appears in the 1851 Mersea Twp. Census, age on next birthday 50.

2. THOMAS² KILLEY (*THOMAS*¹) was born November 19, 1815 in Lezayre, Isle of Man, and died February 02, 1879 in Ontario, Canada. He married ELIZABETH WHITTLE August 17, 1841 in Western District of Canada; a Baptist Church in Gosfield Township, Ontario., daughter of THOMAS WHITTLE and ELIZABETH LEVI. She was born Bet. 1823 - 1829 in Upper Canada, and died November 25, 1901 in Mersea Twp., Essex Co., Ontario, Canada.

Notes for THOMAS KILLEY:

According to one distant cousin, Thomas Killey was a stow-away on a ship bound for Canada when he was only nine years old. After his arrival in Canada, he became a fur trapper, worked at a lumber camp, and may have married a Blackfoot Indian woman.

Whether Thomas Killey came to Canada all by himself or with his parents, it's obvious from census reports that eventually his parents and younger brother came to Essex County, Ontario, Canada, as well. The distant cousin further reports that someone from the Isle of Man was inquiring around Essex County for a Thomas Killey, but whether this unknown man found him or not is not known, nor is the reason for the inquiry.

Registry of Marriages, page 53, Western District of Canada has an entry for "Thomas Kelly m. Elizabeth Whittle August 1 (or 11th) 1841 in Mersea Township. Witnesses were Charles Stewart and Henry Tofflemire." The entry notes also that Banns were read previous to the marriage. The marriage took place in Gosfield Township's Baptist Church.

The Amherstburg Echo, December 6, 1901 printed the following: Killey--in Mersea, on Monday, November 25th; Mrs. Elizabeth Killey, aged 78 years. The obituary follows: "At the house of her son-in-law Geo. Lesley, on the 6th con of Mersea, Mrs. Elizabeth Killey, one of the township's oldest residents passed away on Monday 25th. Deceased was 78 years of age. She was well-known and very highly respected. The funeral on Tuesday was conducted by Rev. A.S. Edwards, and was largely attended. Interment took place at Lakeview cemetery."

Schedule C Deaths for Essex County Division of Mersea notes her birthplace as Essex County, and on daughter Mary's death certificate her birthplace is noted as Mersea Twp. She died of "gastrica." Her religion is noted as Methodist.

He married Ellen Alice Josephine Lewis August 3, 1873 in Bay County, Michigan. State of Michigan Record of Marriages notes Ellen's age as 17 and William's as 25 at last birthday, both resided in "Williamstown," and were married by John McDermott, Justice of the Peace.

1881 Mersea Division 1, Ontario, Canada page 32:

Killy William, male, age 36, birthplace Ontario, C of E, origin Irish, farmer, married. Also included in this census data is wife Ellen age 22, United States born, German; Herbert age 3; Corah age 2; Frederick age 15; Elizabeth age 52. The children are noted as "Irish". Frederick age 15 is William's younger brother. Elizabeth age 52 is William's mother. Her religion is noted as Baptist.

William is in the Bay City Directories between the dates 1899 - 1900, surname spelled Kelley: farmer, sect. 8, 80 acres, \$1100, Williams Twp., P.O. N. Williams.

1902 William Kelly/Kelley/Killey is officially a United States Citizen as of March 28, 1902. Document notes that his intent to declare U.S. Citizenship was filed November 5, 1898.

This record also indicates that daughter Ruby Couture and her children Marguerite, Florence, Herman, and Delorise lived with them, along with daughter Bernice Killey. James Conachan/Conahan was husband to Bernice Killey.

He died May 3, 1925 in Bay County, Michigan, of apoplexy, which was noted on his certificate of death. The death certificate spells the surname "Kelley," and notes he was a farmer. William Killey is buried in Pine Grove Cemetery, Michigan.

Kelly - William Kelly, aged 83, died Sunday at his home in Williams township, following a stroke of apoplexy. He is survived by his wife, Ellen, five children. Herbert Kelly and Mrs. Eva Dingman of Williams Township. Horace, of Midland, Mrs. Coutrier and Mrs. Bernice Lefever, of Bay City, 26 grandchildren, one brother and one sister. Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the home with interment in the Williams township cemetery. (obituary courtesy of Norma Aug. 2007)

Was William married before? Isabella County records show a marriage for a Lucetta Jane Lamphare to a William Kelly -- email from Joan, Jun 13, 2005 says "Found Lucetta Jane Nestle's death in Mentor Cheboygan Co. records. died 13 December 1926 at age 74 years 7 mo 8 days. She is connected to Raymond Lamphear."

Notes for ELLEN ALICE JOSEPHINE LEWIS:

Ellen's birthdate varies up to four years, depending on which documents you look at. Her death record shows a birth date of September 25, 1858.

The 1870 Bay County, Williams, Michigan Census shows her in the household of her parents James M., Renetta, and siblings May, Flora, Addie, Sarah, and Emery, and Ellen age 11.

The 1873 marriage record indicates Ellen's age is 17.

In the 1881 Ontario Census, Mersea Twp., Division 1 she is listed as Ellen, age 22, place of birth United States, of German origin.

In the 1900 Bay County, Williams Township, Michigan Census she is noted as Ellen, wife, female, born June 1854, age 45, married 30 years, gave birth to 8 children, five surviving, born in Wisconsin, parents born in Pennsylvania.

1910 Williams Township, Bay County, Bay City District #66 Michigan Census: Killey, Ellen A.; female; white; age 52, married once; 8 children, 5 living.

The 1920 Bay County, Williams Township, Michigan Census lists her as Ellen, age 61, married, Wisconsin born, parents born in Pennsylvania, in the household of husband William Kelly.

The Bay City Directory from 1935 lists her as Killey, Ellen (Wd. Wm.) r1317 Taylor.

Ellen's death record shows she was living at 404 S. Henry Street (Bay City) for at least nine months, and her usual residence had been Williams Township, Auburn, Michigan. Her birthplace was noted as Wisconsin, her occupation 'housewife,' and she was daughter of James Lewis and Reanette Lewis, both born in Pennsylvania. Mrs. Bernice Lafever was the informant. Ellen Killey died March 16, 1946 at 12:30 a.m. of myocarditis and under 'other contributory causes' was written 'senility.' She was buried March 19, 1946 in Pinegrove Cemetery and was 87 years, 5 months and 21 days at the time of her death.

Killey -- Mrs. Ellen Alice Killey, 87, Auburn, died Saturday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ruby Couturier, 404 South Henry street, following a lingering illness. Born in Wisconsin, Sept. 25, 1858, she was a

resident in and around Auburn since early childhood. Mrs. Killey is survived by a son, herbert, of Auburn, three daughters, Mrs. Bernice Lefevre, of Auburn, Mrs. Ruby Couturier, of Bay City, and Mrs. Eva Dingman, of Mt. Pleasant, a brother, Emery lewis, of Midland; 28 grahdnchildren, 59 great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren. Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the Loose Funeral Home in Auburn with the Rev. Paul W. Plueddemann officiating. Burial will be in the Williams Township cemetery. 5. JAMES³ KILLEY (*THOMAS*², *THOMAS*¹) was born 1842 in Ontario, Canada. He married MARTHA UNKNOWN.

1851 Census: age at next birthday 5, birthplace Canada.

1861 Census: age at next birthday 15, birthplace Upper Canada, religion Church of England, single, labouror.

In the past year, some interesting information about a James Killey has come to light. I include it here as a point of interest, simply because the coincidences seem to many to ignore.

In an email dated 2009, Mr. Gayle asks if we have a connection between his James E/H Killey, because of an obituary notice, the name of his wife, and places James had been. Following is the obituary:

"James H. Killey was found at about seven o'clock Tuesday morning (January 31, 1911) lying at the foot of the stairs that led to his rooming place over the hardware store of Thomas Weir. He had been dead for several hours.

The testimony before the coroner's jury was that he left his companions of the night before about ten o'clock, and started for his room. To get to his lodging place one must go up a narrow flight of stairs and it was at the top of which that he was found onhis hands and knees. Parties who had been spending the evening with James Barber, whose place of business is just across the way, found him and placed him in the bed and left him and that was the last seen of him alive.

During the night he got up and went to the rear door upon the landing and missing his footing, pitched head foremost down to the second landing and then underneath the railing to the ground below, a distance of about ten feet. At the foot of the stairs and to one side is a very heavy trough made of wood for carrying water away from the building. It was upon the edge of this that he struck with his head, inflicting a scalp wound, and fracturing the skull at the base of the brain and breaking his neck. To the back and just below his left shoulder were two wounds.

He was found by James Barber, when the latter went to empty the ash pan. Mr. Barber spoke to him, and receiving no reply, too hold of the prostrate form and found it cold. He called M. G. Kunkle and later the body was taken to the undertaking rooms of J. Burkhart & Son, where the inquest was held Tuesday afternoon, the verdict of the jury being that he came to his death by a fall from the steps and that it was accidental.

He was born in Ontario, Canada, October 8, 1845, and in 1865 came to this country, locating at Little Rock.

Some years were spent in Iowa, and Nebraska. In 1893 he came to Sandwich and secured employment, of late years being in the saw room of the Sandwich Manufacturing Company.

He was married in 1871 to Miss Martha Ellis, of Little Rock, and to whom were born seven children, of whom five survive, Mrs. Jennie Peregoy, of Winnetown, NE., Mrs. Mable (Mabel) Ballou, of Aurora, and James, Gale (Gayle) and Ernest, of this city.

It had been Mr. Killey's intention to go about the first of April to reside with his brother in Michigan.

The funeral services were held this morning at the home of James Killey, his son, where the remains were taken after the inquest, conducted by Rev. J. F. Catlin.

The internment was at Little Rock.
